## Multi-City Study Tour in Spain

### LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

To get up-to-date information about recent intergenerational developments in Spain

To meet practitioners involved in the implementation of intergenerational programs

To get acquainted with local intergenerational program models and cases

### ITINERARY:

#### DAY 1 (Barcelona):

Arrival in Barcelona and orientation.  
Accommodation in Barcelona.

#### DAY 2 (Barcelona):

Host organization: **Viure i Conviure Foundation (Caixa Catalunya)**

Seminar (2 hours) and site visits in Barcelona: Topics covered during this stay will include the planning and implementation of intergenerational homeshare programs. A meeting with practitioners running the Viure i Conviure Foundation's homeshare program will be convened.

Leisure tour.  
Accommodation in Barcelona.

### ITINERARY (continued):

#### DAY 3 (Barcelona & Valencia):

Host organization: **La Nau Gran (University of Valencia)**

Trip Barcelona-Valencia (by train).

Arrival in Valencia and orientation.

Seminar (2 hours) and site visits in Valencia: Topics covered during this stay will include practical strategies in intergenerational programs evaluation. Students will meet participants in local intergenerational programs tackling issues such as the promotion of healthy nutritional habits among children or the fostering of intergenerational arts.

Leisure tour. Accommodation in Valencia.

#### DAY 4 (Valencia & Murcia):

Morning site visit in Valencia: Participants in *School of Grandparents*, an intergenerational program supporting the role of local grandparents in the family as both caregivers and educators, will be met.

Trip Valencia-Murcia (by bus?).

Arrival in Murcia and orientation.

Leisure tour. Accommodation in Murcia.

#### DAY 5 (Murcia & Granada):

Host organization: **University of Murcia**

Seminar (2 hours) and site visits in Murcia: Topics covered during this stay will include professionalization of intergenerational specialists. Students will learn about some local intergenerational programs run in day center for seniors.

Trip Murcia-Granada (by bus).

Arrival in Granada and orientation.  
Accommodation in Granada.

#### DAY 6 (Granada):

Host organization: **OFECUM (older adult organization)**

Seminar (2 hours) and site visits in Granada: Topics covered during this stay will include the Spanish Intergenerational Network and intergenerational programs in schools. A local primary school implementing intergenerational activities will be visited.

Leisure tour.  
Accommodation in Granada.

Study tour ends.



### COST:

Total cost for tour is \$1750.00 inclusive of ground transportation, hotel, all meals, admissions to museums and sites, classes and certificate of credit from Pennsylvania State University.

You will need to decide how to return to Barcelona or fly from Granada to your final destination. If you decide to return to Barcelona, we recommend flying rather than a train which is 12 to 13 hours.
