



THE INTERGENERATIONAL EXPERIENCE

A Multi-city Study Tour

The Pennsylvania State University in partnership with Travel & Learn LLC

A five to seven day study tour designed for students, educators, and practitioners in the intergenerational field (IG) or individuals and groups interested in incorporating intergenerational approaches in their work.

- Tour sites include Spain, Germany, the U.S. mainland, Hawaii and Japan. Other sites will be added in the future.
- Each tour includes a full day seminar led by leading intergenerational specialists in policy development, program design, evaluation, training, volunteer development, community development, and multi-cultural approaches to IG initiatives.
- Three days of each study tour will include visits to intergenerational programs in two to three cities.
- Major themes will be selected for each tour allowing time to integrate leisure excursions. For example, the 2009 study tour to Hawai`i will include a focus on the diversity of Hawaii's cultural legacy.
- Within a two to three week period following the study tour, participants will receive personal assistance with planning for new programs in their own communities based on ideas gleaned from the tour.

STUDY TOUR PARTICIPANTS WILL:

- Learn about innovative intergenerational strategies to enrich the lives of individuals, strengthen families, and build communities.
- Receive 4.5 Continuing Education Unit Credits and a certificate of completion from The Pennsylvania State University.
- Join the growing international network of intergenerational practitioners, educators and policymakers.

EACH TOUR WILL BE LIMITED TO TEN PARTICIPANTS

Cost for tour is inclusive of everything except airfare, personal incidentals and travel insurance. Tour costs will depend on the sites selected for a given tour.
